The Danish Neighbourhood Programme has the overall objective to promote a peaceful and stable Europe with freedom and progress. The Programme has two thematic objectives: i) Promoting human rights and democracy, and ii) Strengthening sustainable and inclusive economic growth. Programme interventions contribute to the development of a democratic society with responsible and accountable authorities, an active civil society as well as free and well-functioning markets.

The Neighbourhood Programme has been developed in close consultations with relevant partners in Georgia and builds on the Sustainable Development Goals, the priorities of Georgia, Denmark's Strategy for Development Cooperation and Humanitarian Action 2017 as well as trade and commercial interests. Programme interventions are implemented by partners that all are selected based on their proven ability to deliver results.

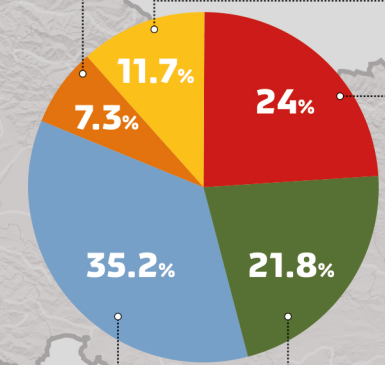
