



PRIORITISED CRISES 2021

The Minister for Development Cooperation has (in 2020) approved the following list of protracted humanitarian crisis that will be prioritised within the framework of the Strategic Partnerships between Danish civil society organisations and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark throughout 2021:

- Existing priorities: Myanmar, Afghanistan, Iraq, Syria, Palestine, Yemen, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan, Central African Republic, and Mali.
- New priorities: Ethiopia, Lake Chad Bassin, and Libya.

All priorities include efforts for refugees and host communities in neighbouring countries.
