Coronavirus Disease COVID-19**

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark, Protocol Department, presents its compliments to all Heads of Diplomatic Missions accredited to Denmark and to International Organizations and Other Missions resident in Copenhagen and has the honour to share the following:

Due to the serious development of the Corona virus in Denmark, the Danish Government has decided to reduce manning of all public institutions to the minimum required to ensure efficient response to the crisis and other core tasks as well as the continued functioning of critical infrastructure. Accordingly, most of the staff of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs like other ministries and public authorities are working from home, and the ability of the Ministry to respond to requests and questions from diplomatic missions is limited.
