



Suspicion of irregularities in relation to Skive College`s activities in Kenya

Reference is made to the previous report dated 18 December 2025 regarding suspicions of irregularities on a grant to Skive College (SC). GLOBUS has been granted DKK 18.8 mio. annually in the period 2023-2025, of which DKK 1,496,184 has been granted to Skive College in 2023 for the project, "International collaboration with Kenya".

An additional audit has been conducted to clarify all expenses of the student trip to Kenya. The report concluded several areas of irregularities including conflict of interest related to the arranged accommodation, expensive double booking of accommodation and flights, expenses related to transport were not cost efficient, and some expenses were not supported by receipts. The total amount confirmed to be related to the irregularities is DKK 35,632, including DKK 26,991.39 to be undocumented costs, and DKK 8,642 to be related to the expensive double booking of accommodation.

GLOBUS has confirmed that SC has reimbursed the DKK 35,632, and that the project has ended, including the cooperation with the local partner in Kenya. As of January 2026, GLOBUS has changed the modalities, making feasibility study trips a separate grant to be reported before the actual project can be granted.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs thus regards the case as closed without loss of Danish funds.
