



Suspicion of irregularities relating to PlanBørnefondens partner in Kenya

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Reference is made to the previous report dated 30 March 2026 regarding suspicions of irregularities on a grant to PlanBørnefondens implemented by Plan International Kenya (PIK). DKK 1,000,000 has been granted for the period 2022-2025. A Youth Led Organization named Slums Going Green and Clean (SGGC) was selected as beneficiary of the Youth Climate Action Accelerator Grant to scale up existing climate adaptation and environmental regeneration initiatives. DKK 29,497 has been disbursed to SGGC to procure equipment for the project.

As of today, SGGC has neither procured the equipment, accounted for the funds, nor refunded the amount, despite repeated requests to do so. PIK has assessed the available options for recovering the funds, taking into consideration legal advice, the likelihood of recovery, the costs associated with pursuing recovery of the funds, and the potential impact on ongoing programmes, including reputational considerations and the risk of community hostility. Based on the legal assessment, PIK concluded that neither further arbitration nor criminal proceedings would offer a reasonable likelihood of recovering the funds in proportion to the costs, risks, and resources that would be required. Consequently, no further legal action is considered appropriate at this stage.

The loss of DKK 29,497 has been covered by PIK.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs thus regards the case as closed without loss of Danish funds.
