



Suspicion of irregularities in relation to The Day After's activities in Syria

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark (MFA) provides support to the organisation, The Day After (TDA), to promote accountability, human rights, and civil liberties in Syria. The MFA has supported TDA since 2016. The current engagement ends by the end of March 2026 with a grant of DKK 9 million which has been disbursed.

In October 2025, whistle-blowers contacted the MFA with a number of allegations regarding TDA. The allegations consisted of breach of HR practices, conflict of interest in selection of sub-contractors, financial mismanagement, and harassment.

Based on the documentation presented by the whistle-blowers, KPMG was contracted to conduct a forensic audit of TDA. The audit, which was concluded in March 2026, did not substantiate the allegations made by the whistle-blowers, while identifying lack of supporting documentation for expenses amounting to DKK 71,500 (USD 11,102) related to the Danish funding.

The main findings have been discussed with TDA. TDA maintains that the documentation exists and can be provided, however they need additional time to locate it. MFA is awaiting confirmation from TDA on when the documentation will be delivered.

The process has been closely coordinated with Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency, who also funds TDA.

A new report will be forwarded when there are further developments in the case.
