



Suspicion of irregularities in relation to Uraia Trust's activities in Kenya

Reference is made to the previous report dated 1 December 2025 regarding unauthorized cash withdrawals on a grant to Uraia Trust, which implements its activities through sub-partners, with the aim of enhancing civil society participation, engagement, and oversight. DKK 90 million was granted to Uraia for the period 2021-2025, of which DKK 89,655,104 was disbursed. Of this amount, a total of DKK 175,000 was disbursed to the Kenya Young Parliamentarians Association (KYPA), a bipartisan caucus that brings together young Kenyan parliamentarians.

In May 2023, allegations arose regarding suspicion of unauthorized cash withdrawals from the KYPA's project bank account. It was established that two unprocedural withdrawals of project funds took place without the knowledge of the entity's Chief Executive Officer, and in violation of their internal financial procedures. The amount under suspicion was DKK 88,600.

A total of DKK 68,964 was refunded in the period January 2024 to November 2025. Recovery of the remaining DKK 19,636 was successfully identified after the MFA engaged Kenya's Auditor General to the case, who requested the Speaker of the National Assembly to instruct the KYPA members, who had misappropriated the funds, to return them. Subsequently, the full amount of DKK 19,636 was returned in January 2026. The Auditor General advised the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs that no further action against KYPA is necessary, as all funds had been refunded.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs thus regards the case as closed without loss of Danish funds.
