

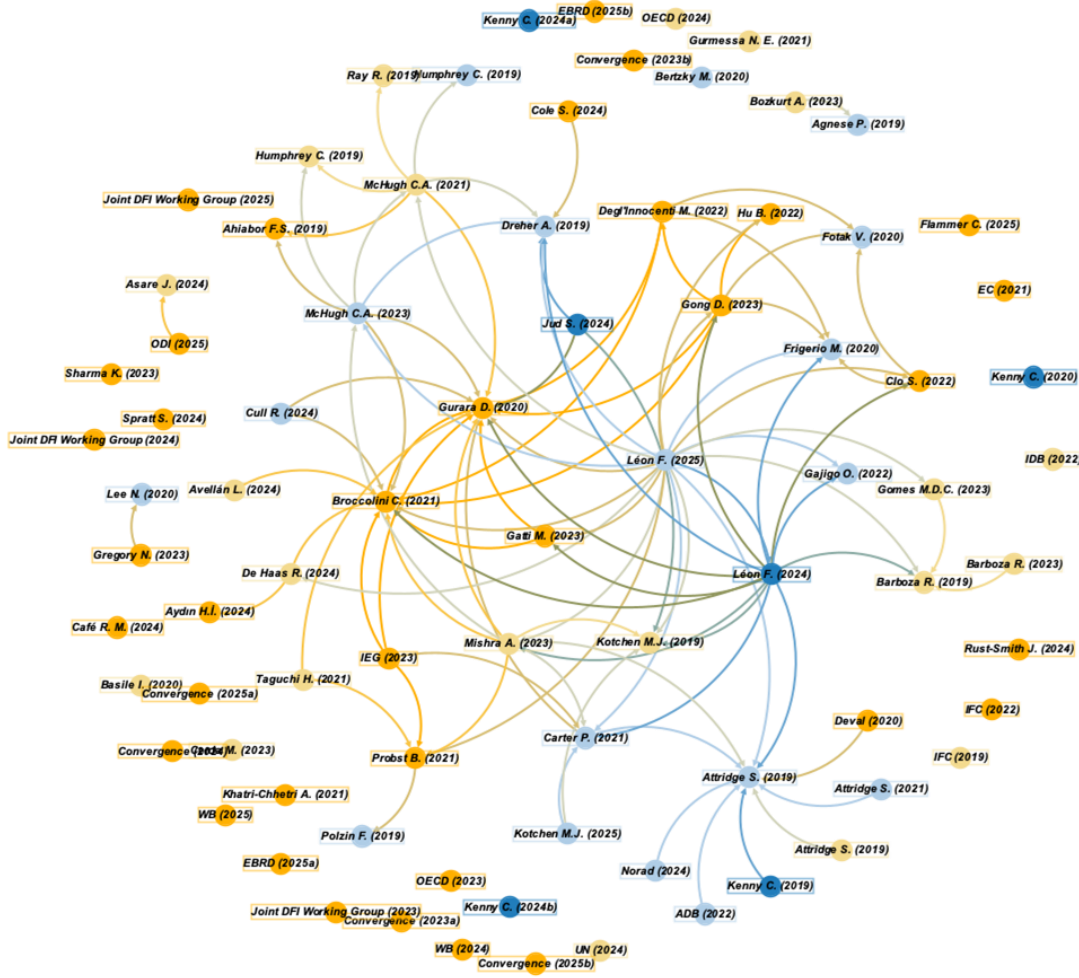

Annex Table 1: Colour codes for interpreting citation network attributes

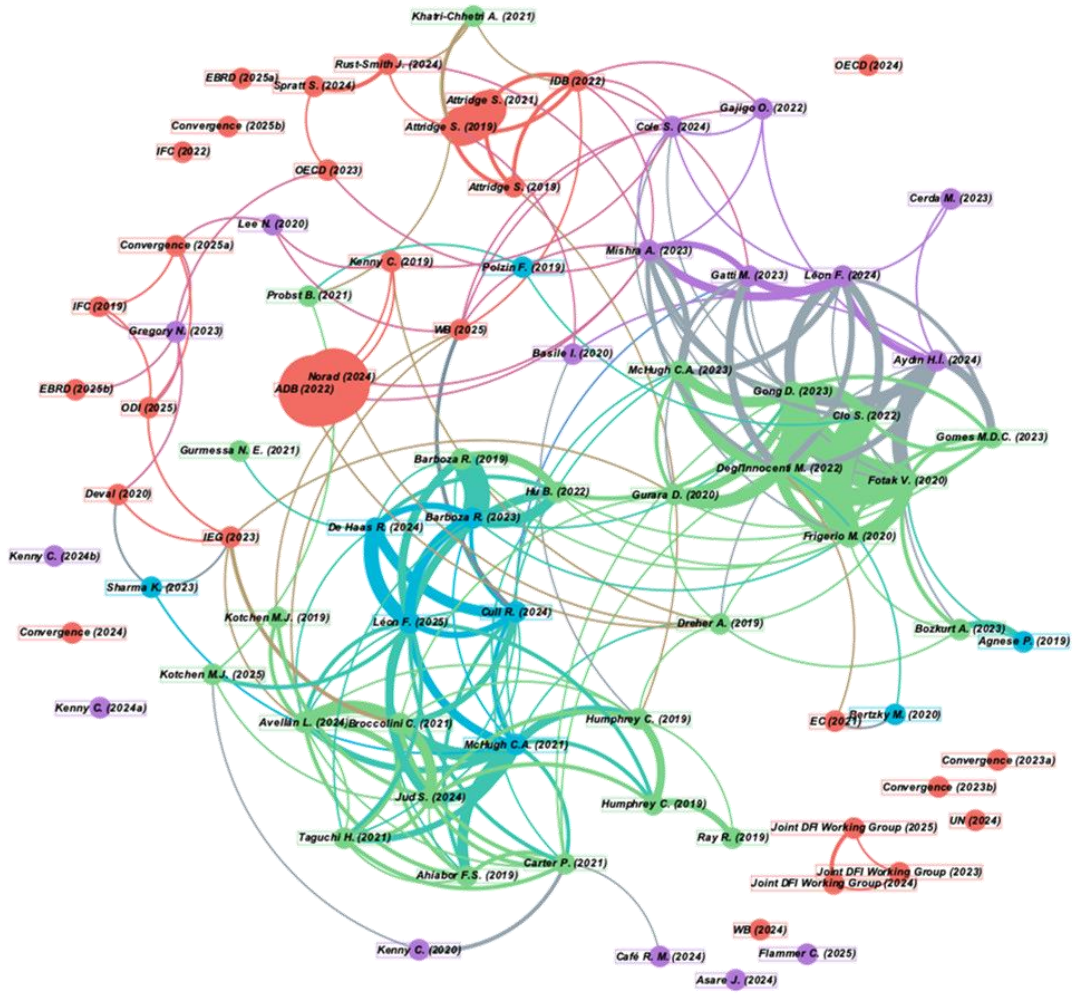
Attribute	Colour	Meaning
Support for Blended Finance	Orange	Unambiguously positive. Sees blended finance as an effective tool (even with acknowledged challenges).
	Yellow	Notes challenges but ultimately views blended finance as valuable and worth supporting, often with recommended improvements.
	Light Blue	Acknowledges some merits but largely focuses on risks, limitations, or shortcomings.
	Blue	Fundamentally critical. Sees blended finance as ineffective or even counterproductive in its current form.
Document type	Blue	Institutional report (e.g. UN, development banks, think tanks)
	Green	Peer-reviewed journal article
	Purple	Working or discussion paper (pre-publication, grey literature)
	Orange	Review paper or synthesis
Terminology Use	Yellow	Explicitly uses the term " <i>blended finance</i> "
	Blue	Does not use the term, though related concepts may be discussed

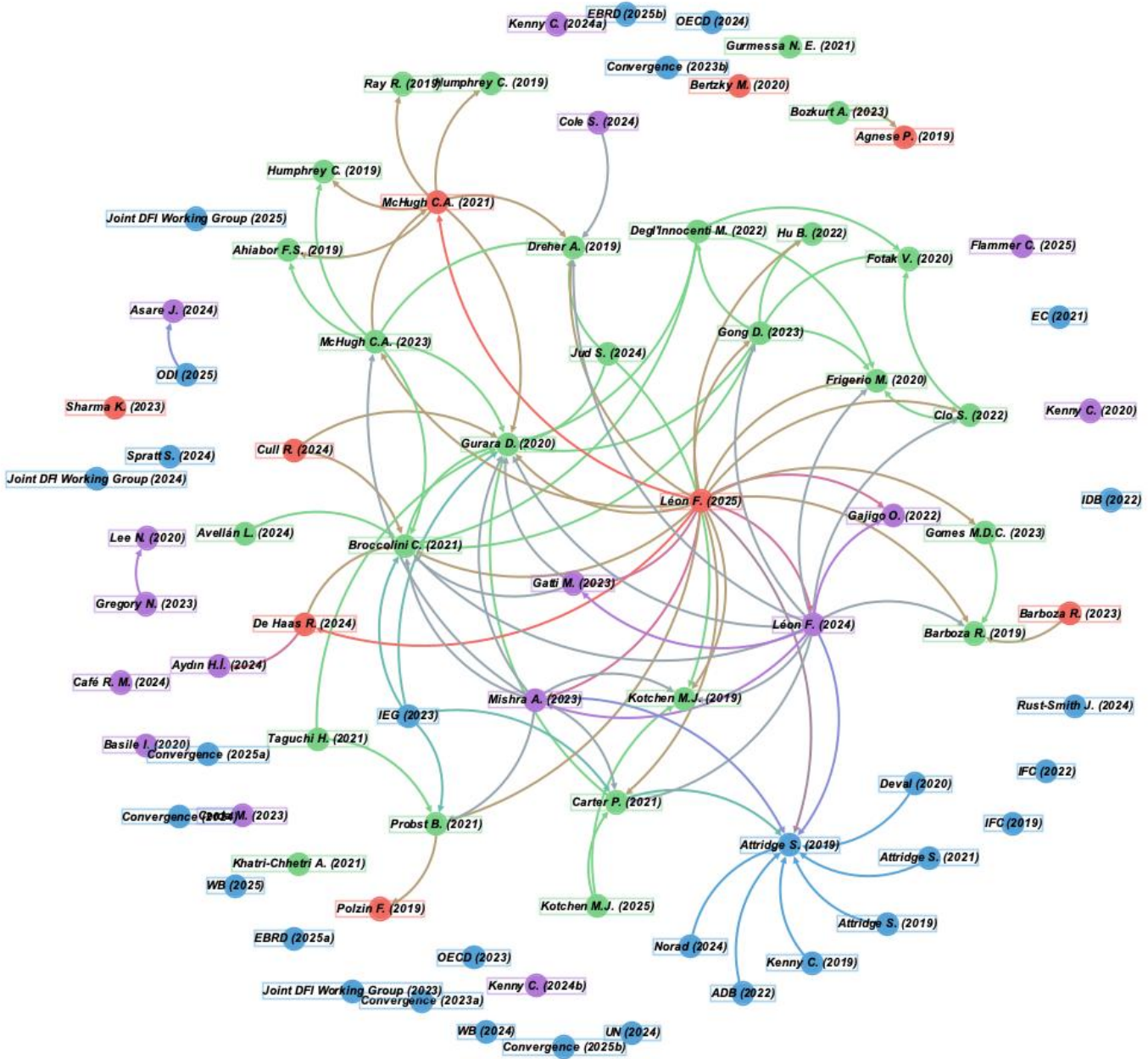
(A) Citation network showing the support for blended finance



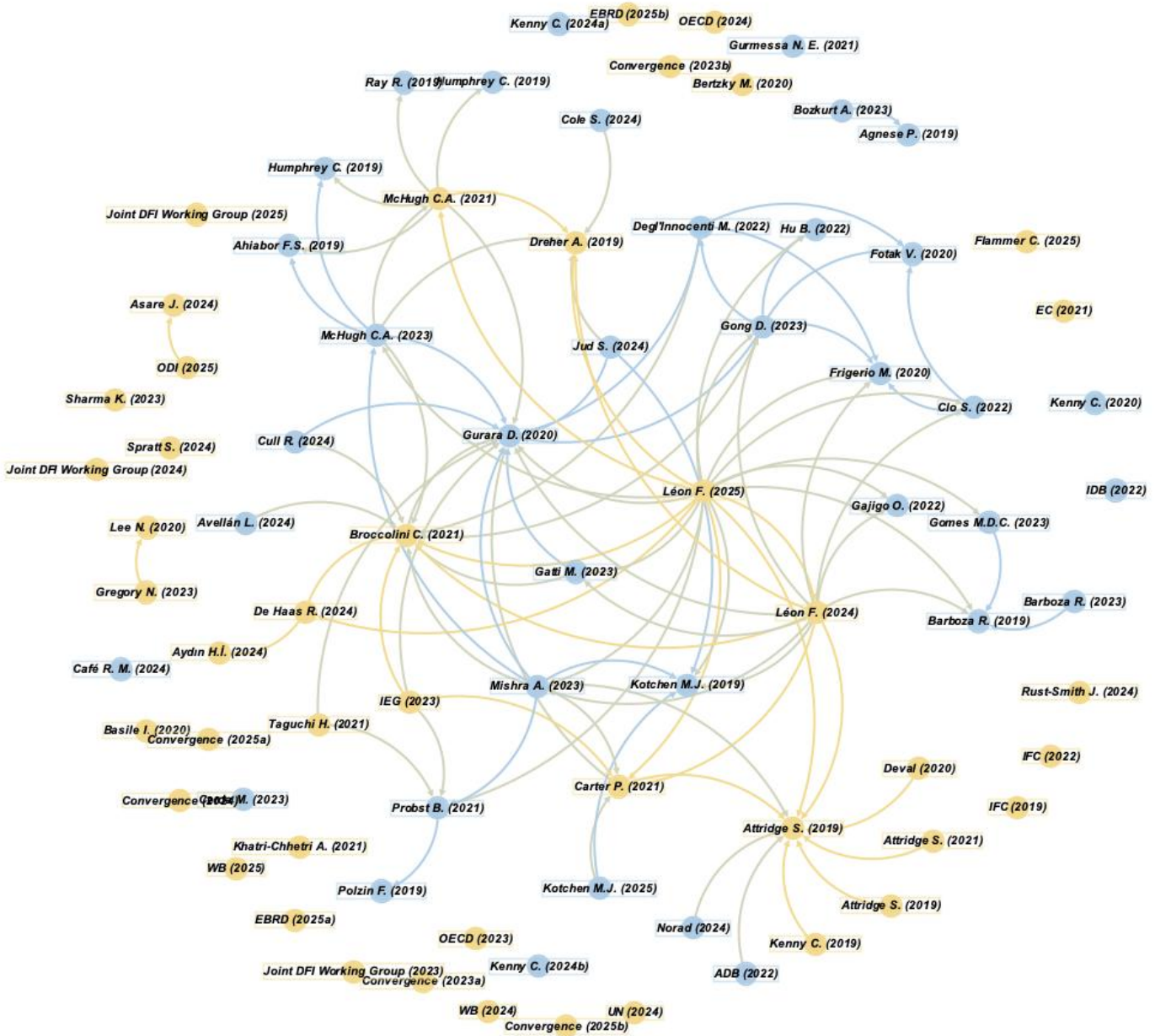
(B) Shared reference network showing the different document types
