
Thank you for your Government's reply to my letter of 21 November, in which I availed myself of the power of inquiry under Article 52 of the European Convention of Human Rights.

Unfortunately, the explanations provided by your Government do not address all the questions in enough detail (see the enclosed copy of my report of 28 February [SG/Inf(2006)5]). I am therefore writing to ask you to provide supplementary explanations on the following points:

- control mechanisms (administrative, judicial, parliamentary or other) in respect of activities of foreign intelligence services within the jurisdiction of your State, whether they are conducted in co-operation with national agencies or not (please note that in this context, available control mechanisms regarding national agencies should be indicated, and whether they extend to foreign agencies);
- control mechanisms regarding transiting aircraft which may be used for rendition purposes by foreign agencies and whether and to what extent your authorities may exercise jurisdiction over such aircraft.

I should be grateful if you would send me the necessary supplementary explanations without delay and at the latest by 7 April.
